Community Summer Employment Project is a 9-week work summer experience program that assists with various clean-up and maintenance projects aimed at improving the quality of life for core area residents in your community.

The program combines classroom training, safety certificates and training, and on-the-job work experience. The summer work experience focuses on beautifying core areas in <u>your community</u>.

The Team Lead will mentor and supervise the Youth Trainees (4 per team) during the 9 week program and schedule youth trainee activities in the community. The Team Lead will be responsible for coordinating the program and implementing activities, ensuring timelines and milestones are met, documenting activities and completing activity reports.

The Team Lead will start on June 24th, 2019 with Youth Trainees starting on July 2nd, 2019 and the project will end August 30th, 2019. Monday – Friday, 37.5 hours a week.

Skills & Qualifications:

- Demonstrated experience supervising staff teams or work crews
- General labourer experience including yard maintenance experience
- Experience and knowledge in the use of small hand and power tools including lawn mowers, hedge trimmers, and grass trimmers
- Physically fit, able to work outdoors and lift and move objects
- · Ability to establish work priorities and ensure deadlines are met and procedures are followed
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Valid driver's license and reliable vehicle to transport youth trainees to work sites
- Experience working with the Aboriginal community
