We are seeking an experienced Electrician Journeyperson to fill a temporary full-time position in Winnipeg to complete electrical maintenance and installation duties associated with streetlighting infrastructure, controls, and other electrical installations.

Responsibilities:

- Perform maintenance, repairs, installation, additions, and modifications to the streetlighting equipment and systems in the DOM – Winnipeg Operations area and other locations as required.
- Perform repairs, troubleshooting, inspection, and maintenance of a variety of electrical equipment such as streetlighting secondary supply sources, lighting control cabinets, underground and overhead outdoor lighting circuits, and lighting structures.
- Perform installation and commissioning of electrical apparatus and associated controls used in streetlighting systems.
- Perform electrical construction and commissioning of new streetlighting installations.
- Ensure maintenance records, print revisions/as-builts, and eGIS mapping systems accurately reflect field installations.
- Assist with the preparation of estimates, material lists, and requisitions associated with additions and modifications.
- May be required to act as a safety watcher, ensuring all corporate and provincial safety regulations, policies, and practices are adhered to.
- Provide direction and training to junior staff, including Power Line Technician Journeypersons assigned to work area.
- Prepare clear and concise reports of all work performed using Microsoft Office applications.
- Use of the MWM system to open and close daily work orders as well as the ability to generate corrective work orders.

Qualifications:

- Must possess a Grade 12 education and a Manitoba Certificate of Qualification as a Construction Journeyperson Electrician and a valid Manitoba Department of Labor Construction Journeyperson Electrician's Licence.
- Must have one year of experience in the installation and maintenance of electrical equipment and systems associated with outdoor lighting.
- Ability to work with minimal supervision from diagrams, blueprints, manuals, electronic mapping systems, and oral and written instructions.
- Proven diagnostic skills and abilities.
- Familiar with the use of electrical measuring instruments, devices, equipment, and apparatus, and the interpretation of schematics and construction drawings.
- Capable of providing direction to junior employees and able to work harmoniously with fellow employees.
- Possess an approved set of personal hand tools.
- Physically capable of performing the duties of the position (i.e., ability to work at heights, etc.).
- Familiar with and adhere to Manitoba Hydro Safety Rules, corporate policies, union contracts, the Canadian Electrical Code, WHMIS, Dangerous Goods Regulations, and other approved practices and procedures.
- Required to wear Flame Resistant Clothing as specified by Manitoba Hydro's Enterprise Safety Department.

- Capable of communicating effectively both orally and in writing.
- Possess, or be willing to obtain, a Manitoba Hydro Equipment Operator's Permit appropriate to the equipment to be operated (bucket truck, platform person lift, radial boom digger).
- Familiar with Manitoba Hydro standards and safety practices for installing poles, anchors, street light standards, and bases in the distribution system.
- Possess a valid Province of Manitoba Driver's Licence, Class 3 with air brake endorsement.
- Willing to participate in personal development, including select internal Manitoba Hydro modules related to the scope of work.
