- Plan, develop, deploy, and improve integrated frameworks and tools for enterprise planning, performance measurement, and business review processes.
- In collaboration with Business Units, Enterprise Risk Management, and the Enterprise Strategy, Risk & Enablement Business Unit, monitor, maintain, and help improve and integrate key enterprise alignment systems such as Enterprise Performance Management, as well as enterprise and divisional planning processes.
- Participates and/or leads cross-functional, multi-disciplinary teams for Enterprise planning that deals with complex strategic issues relating to the alignment of Enterprise, Business Unit, and divisional plans to Strategy.
- Make recommendations and undertake opportunities for innovating enterprise planning processes by leveraging data and analytics to drive impactful decision-making and identify opportunities for automation and other advanced digital capabilities.
- Co-coordinates the Business Planning Community of Practice and makes recommendations to improve its effectiveness.
